

CAMP INSTRUCTION

Professional instruction will be provided at all times and individual instruction is provided at each session. A certified athletic trainer will be on site at all times.

CAMP DETAILS

\$50 - HIGH SCHOOL SELECT CAMP (Grades 9-12)

Oct. 4, Kraft Field (1-5 p.m.)

Deadline to register is Sept. 20 (limited to 80 players)

The Select Camp is designed for up-and-coming high school prospects who want to enhance their baseball skills to an optimal level. Players will be evaluated on their baseball skills, knowledge and performance. They will also learn how to progress both on and off the field and increase knowledge regarding all facets of baseball.

\$60 - PITCHER/CATCHER CAMP (Ages 8-18)

Nov. 1, Hyslop Sports Center (1-5 p.m.)

Deadline to register is Oct. 18 (limited to 50 players)

This camp is designed specifically for pitchers and catchers. These athletes will receive instruction on the fundamentals of pitching and catching which will translate into success on the field.

\$60 - SKILLS CAMP I & II (Ages 8-18)

Camp I - Nov. 8, Hyslop Sports Center (1-5 p.m.)

Camp II - Nov. 15, Hyslop Sports Center (1-5 p.m.)

Deadline to register is Oct. 25 for Camp 1 and Nov. 1 for Camp II (limited to 60 players per camp)

The Fighting Sioux skill camps will cover all fundamentals of the game, including hitting, pitching, throwing, fielding and base running. Campers will have the opportunity to learn the little intricacies of the game that lead to improved performance on the field.

\$60 - HITTING SCHOOLS (Ages 8-18)

Nov. 29, Dec. 6 and Dec. 13, Hyslop Sports Center

Deadline to register for these three camps are Nov. 15, Nov. 22 and Nov. 29 (limited to 24 players per hour)

1-2 p.m. (Ages 8-12)

2-3 p.m. (Ages 13-18)

3-4 p.m. (All Ages)

This specialized hitting school is designed for players who want to improve their approach at the plate by learning the same mechanics and approaches used by hitters at the Division I level.

CAMP FACILITIES

The North Dakota Fighting Sioux baseball team plays its home games at historic **Kraft Field**, a city-owned stadium located in Grand Forks, N.D. The facility includes bleacher seating for 2,000 in a picturesque setting with evergreen trees lining the outfield fence.

The facility is named after longtime UND head coach Harold "Pinky" Kraft, who restarted the university's baseball program in 1956. In 1992 and 2004, Kraft Field was the site of the North Central Conference Baseball Championships.

In case of inclement weather, all camps will be moved to the **Hyslop Sports Center** on the UND campus.

Built in 1951, the Hyslop Sports Center, then known as the UND Fieldhouse was a major upgrade in facilities. When the North Dakota Legislature, behind the urging of State Senators Joseph B. Bridston and Carroll E. Day, both of Grand Forks, appropriated \$500,000 for the Fieldhouse in 1947, it was the largest appropriation for an athletic facility at UND since \$25,000 was given in 1907 and \$35,000 was given in 1919 to complete the federally-built shell that became the Armory.

LIABILITY WAIVER

Prior to admittance to participate in any of the baseball camps provided by UND, players are required to complete a liability waiver form. The form can be downloaded by going to the baseball page on FightingSioux.com and clicking on the link called 'Camps' on the right-hand side. The form must be completely filled out and sent in with prior payment and registration.

REGISTRATION

Due to space and staffing allocations, registration is on a first-come, first-serve basis and must be received two weeks prior to the camp date. **In order to be fully registered, players must send in the REGISTRATION CARD AND LIABILITY WAIVER and make full payment to:**
