Fighting Sioux head coach Gene Roebuck is the winningest coach in NCAA Division II basketball — men's or women's — with an astounding .856 career winning percentage. In his 21 seasons at UND, Roebuck has guided the Fighting Sioux to four NCAA Division II championship games, including back-to-back-back national titles in 1997, 1998 and 1999, and 11 North Central Conference championships. Roebuck has coached four national players of the year and 17 All-Americans and is a 10-time NCC Coach of the Year.

- ▶ Winningest coach in DII history (.856 win pct.)
- ▶ More than 500 career wins at UND
- ▶ Has led UND to three NCAA Division II national championships (1999, 1998, 1997)
- ▶ Has earned 18 consecutive NCAA postseason appearances

- ▶ Has won seven consecutive NCC Playoff Championship titles
- ▶ Ten-time NCC Coach of the Year
- ▶ Five-time NDAPSSA Female College Coach of the Year
- ▶ Has guided seven NCC MVPs and more than 50 All-NCC players
- ▶ Eighteen consecutive seasons of 20+ victories
- ▶ Member of the Mayville State University Athletic Hall of Fame

CAMP INSTRUCTION

Professional instruction will be provided at all times and individual instruction is provided at each session. Athletic training facilities are available during the camp and a certified athletic trainer will be on site at all times during sessions.

CAMP SUPERVISION

GRADES 9-12: CHECK-POINT PROGRAM

All campers entering grades 9-12 beginning in Fall 2008 and who will be staying on campus will be housed in the University's daily check-in program. This program has four daily camper check-in times through the scheduled camp itinerary. The check-in is the responsibility of the camper and takes place after breakfast, lunch, and either before or after dinner, and at bed check. Campers are restricted to campus property; however, they will be able to visit all campus facilities (except the University's summer school hall and adult conference hall) without being accompanied by a University employee.

GRADES 6-8: SUPERVISED PROGRAM

All campers entering grades 6-8 beginning in Fall 2008 and who will be staying on campus will be housed in the University's supervision program. This program offers controlled boundaries and no flexibility for on or off-campus private time for the camper. Campers are escorted to and from all scheduled activities throughout camp. In addition, campers have limited time in their residence hall room during scheduled nightly programs.
