Scouting Ball State: The Cardinals 2-2 overall will begin a three game road-swing as they take on North Dakota State Friday and North Dakota Sunday. Ball State defeated Valparaiso Tuesday night in Worthen Arena, 71-64. The Cardinals victory was the first win over Valparaiso in Worthen Arena. Senior forward Danielle Gratton led the Cardinals offensively with a 17 point performance. Senior guard Audrey McDonald scored 11 points, while sophomore guard Patrice King added 10 to the victory. Junior forward Emily Maggert chipped in nine points and led defensively with 14 rebounds. Ball State faces North Dakota State Friday for a 5 p.m. (CT) tipoff before it heads to the University of North Dakota to take on the Fighting Sioux Sunday at 2 p.m. (CT). The Cardinals are coached by Kelly Packard who is in her second season at Ball State. She owns a 28-11 overall record with the Cardinals.

Scouting North Dakota State: North Dakota State heads into Friday's game with a 1-3 overall record. The Bison won their first contest over Northern Iowa (64-62) but have dropped their last three since their season opener. North Dakota State has falling to DePaul, Wyoming and Minnesota. Head Coach Carolyn DeHoff is in her first season with the Bison.

Scouting North Dakota: North Dakota has started off the season with a 1-4 overall record. The Fighting Sioux dropped three straight to Green Bay (56-74), Wisconsin (43-68), Wyoming (59-85) before earning their first victory over New Mexico State Monday, 57-50. North Dakota lost 85-46 to Gonzaga Wednesday evening. The Fighting Sioux are currently 0-2 at home this season. North Dakota is coached by Gene Roebuck who is in his 22nd season.

Ball State defeated NDSU 65-54 in the finals of the 2005 Ball State Credit Union Classic in Muncie. The game versus North Dakota is also only the second meeting between the two schools. Ball State leads the all-time series record 1-0. The Cardinals earned an 88-80 overtime victory over North Dakota in 2009 at Worthen Arena.

On This Date:

On this date Nov. 27 Ball State owns an overall record of 3-2. On this exact date in 2005 Ball State and North Dakota State met for the first time in Muncie, Ind. The Cardinals won that game 65-54. On this date Nov. 29 Ball State owns a 4-1 overall record. The last time in the Cardinals played on Nov. 29 was in 2003-04 when they defeated East Carolina by a score of 81-78.

Ball State Picked Second In Preseason MAC: The Ball State Cardinals have been picked to finish second in the Mid-American Conference West Division pre-season poll with 14 votes, while Toledo was chosen to finish first with 18 votes. Bowling Green was again tabbed to finish on top in the MAC East Division and to win the MAC Tournament Championship.

Gratton and Maggert Named Preseason All-MAC: Senior forward Danielle Gratton and teammate junior forward Emily Maggert were named preseason All-MAC by the conference office in late October. Gratton averaged 11.7 points per game while leading the team in rebounding with 7.0 a contest last season. Maggert shot 54 percent from the field last year leading her team in field goal percentage. She also led the Cardinals in points with 470 and was third in rebounding averaging with 6.0 boards a game.

McDonald Closing In On the Three-Point Record: Senior guard Audrey McDonald is currently in second place in the Ball State all-time record books for three pointers made. McDonald has 247 three pointers for her career and needs seven to take the top spot, which is held by former Cardinal Johna Goff (2001-04) with 253 three pointers.

Newest Member of the 1,000th Point Club: Senior guard Audrey McDonald became the newest member of the Ball State women's basketball 1,000th point club Saturday, Nov. 21. McDonald currently ranks 20th on the list and has exactly 1,000 points for her career.

King One Shy Of Career High: Sophomore guard Patrice King was just one point shy of her career high 16 points in the Cardinals win Saturday against Northern Arizona. King knocked down 15 points against the Lumberjacks.

Rebound That Basketball: The Cardinals return 71 percent of their rebounding from last season led by senior Danielle Gratton who had 244 rebounds and junior Emily Maggert who pulled down 211 boards. Maggert has started the season off with double-doubles in the Cardinals first three contests. Maggert currently has five double-doubles for her career at BSU.

Ball State Introduces Three Freshmen: BSU welcomes three freshmen to its squad this season, Chloe Barnes (Quincy, IL), Shanee' Jackson (Hilliard, OH), and Mercedes Miller (Huber Heights, OH).

About Barnes: Attended Notre Dame ... averaged 17.0 points per game while shooting 61 percent from the field as a senior ... averaged 5.6 rebounds ... she ended her career at Notre Dame with a total of 2,024 points ... helped the Raiders to a 28-1 overall record last season.

About Jackson: Attended Hilliard Darby ... averaged 15.0 points, 6.0 rebounds

and 4.0 assists as a senior ... Named All-Ohio Capital Conference and Second Team All-District ... helped Hilliard Darby to a 60-29 overall record over four year.

About Miller: Attended Wayne High School ... as a senior, averaged 20.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 2.5 steals per game ... led the Greater Western Ohio Conference in scoring two years in a row.

Muncie Welcomes Back One Of Its Own : Junior transfer Ty'Ronda Benning is the first hometown women's basketball player to be on Ball State's roster since Christy Jones in 1999-2000. Jones was from Muncie Central and lettered one year for the Cardinals. Benning is a Muncie Southside graduated and transferred from Lincoln Trail where she was a two-year letterwinner. Played for Chad Killenger. Second all-time in scoring with 900 career points. Averaged 18.6 points per game, 5.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists in 2008-09. Regional 24 Player of the Year. Earned All-American and all-conference honors.

Looking Ahead: The Cardinals will face five teams in non-conference action that were postseason participants in 2008-09. Wisconsin-Green Bay and Evansville both went to the NCAA Tournament last season, while Illinois State, Duquesne and Butler played in the WNIT.

Benning Makes A Great Start: Junior guard Ty'Ronda Benning in her starting debut as a Cardinals knocked in 13 points while grabbing eight rebounds in Ball State's season opener at Michigan.

Ball State Inks Four During Early Signing Period: Ball State women's basketball coach Kelly Packard has announced the signing of her 2010 recruiting class. **Jazmin Hitchens** (St. Louis, Mo./Incarnate Word Academy), **Jordan Huber** (Indianapolis, Ind./Ben Davis), **Katie Murphy** (Peoria, Ill./Richwoods) and **Brandy Woody** (Thorntown, Ind./Western Boone) who have all signed national letters of intent to enroll at Ball State University and compete on the women's basketball team. **Hitchens**, a 6-0 forward from St. Louis, Mo., averaged 14.2 points per game and 6.6 rebounds last season. **Huber**, a 5-7 guard from Indianapolis, Ind., averaged five points per game while helping Ben Davis High School to a 33-0 record, a No. 1 national ranking and the Indiana State Championship. **Murphy**, a 6-0 forward from Peoria, Ill., averaged 10.4 points per game and 7.6 rebounds in 2008-09. She helped Peoria Richwoods High School win the Illinois State Championship. **Woody**, a 5-6 guard from Thorntown, Ind., averaged 19 points per game while pulling down 8.8 boards and dishing out 7.8 assists last season at Western Boone. She also was an Indiana Junior All-Star.

Fun Facts: • Ball State senior forward Danielle Gratton earned a bachelor's degree from Ball State in communications in the spring of 2009. Gratton is currently working on a masters degree. • Ball State sophomore forward Amber Crago who formerly was Amber Clark was married August 1, 2009 to her husband Kraegan Crago.

Packard Names Three Captains For 2009-10 Season: Head Coach Kelly Packard named seniors Danielle Gratton and Audrey McDonald along with junior Emily Maggert as the captains for the 2009-10 season.

McDonald And Her Three's: Senior guard Audrey McDonald has hit a three point basket in her last seven contests dating back to last season. The most McDonald has made in a game was nine in 2007-08 at home vs. Western Michigan.

The Great State of Indiana: A total of 14 women's basketball players will be from the state of Indiana Tuesday in the Cardinals game against Valparaiso. The Crusaders have a total of 10 on their roster while Ball State has four.

The Next Game: The Ball State women's basketball team will play Missouri Friday, Dec. 5. The game will begin at 12:30 p.m. (CT). This will be the second meeting between Ball State and Missouri. The Tigers lead the all-time series record 1-0 over the Cardinals. The last time the two schools met was in 2002-03 which resulted in a 88-77 loss for Ball State.
