

## 2003-04 NCC Tournament

Senior Barrett Ganje, junior Scott Sorvaag, sophomore Terry Kragero and freshmen Dan Peterson and Duane Wages combined to lead UND to a fifth-place finish at the 2003 North Central Conference Tournament, an improvement of two spots from the previous year.

Kragero was the individual story for UND, shooting a three-day 214 – including a sparkling second-round 68 – to finish in sixth-place. The top-10 showing ensured Kragero a spot on the All-NCC Second Team for the second consecutive year.

Peterson also turned in a strong performance, particularly for a freshman, tying for 18th with a 222. His score of 73 on the final day was the lowest among UND golfers.

Ganje and Sorvaag each tied with two other golfers in 23rd place, and Wages – a Grand Forks native – tied for 31st in his first taste of NCC Tournament action.

South Dakota's Robb Bierbaum took medalist honors with a 203 (68-69-66) and led the Coyotes to a four-stroke victory over Augustana.

## Head Coach Rob Stiles



### Head Coach Rob Stiles

Rob Stiles is in his 18th year as head coach of the Fighting Sioux men's golf team. His tenure at UND runs much longer, however, as he served as the school's head wrestling

coach prior to taking over the golf program

In 1999, Stiles led the Sioux to their fourth consecutive NCC Tournament title. These four titles are part of the 18 NCC Championships that UND has won in 62 years of competition.

The Turlock, Calif. native has also served as the golf professional at UND's Ray Richards Golf Course for the past 20 years.

Stiles attended Oregon State for one year before transferring to Modesto (Calif.) Junior College. Following graduation from Modesto, Stiles attended Cal Poly-San Luis Obispo for one year. An all-around athlete, Stiles competed in football, track and wrestling as a collegian. Following a stint in the U.S. Army, where he also competed in wrestling, Stiles came to UND and earned his bachelor's degree in physical education in 1970 and master's degree in 1971.

Stiles is a member of the NCAA Northwest Region Golf Committee and the National Golf Coaches Association.

## 2003-04 Season in Review

In 2002-03, the Fighting Sioux had little depth to speak of and routinely relied on freshman Terry Kragero as its top golfer from week-to-week. But in 2003-04, a handful of emerging golfers stepped forward to help Head Coach Rob Stiles field a deeper squad. As a result, UND was led by a different golfer on five occasions.

Kragero, now a sophomore, remained UND's best, earning All-NCC Second Team honors for the second time in as many seasons and advancing to the NCAA Regional Tournament for the first time in his career. But much of the burden was lifted from the Fargo, N.D., native's shoulders by the likes of Dan Peterson, Duane Wages, Scott Sorvaag and Barrett Ganje.

Wages, a freshman, led UND at three different tournaments, while classmate Peterson was UND's top finisher at one, the Irv Kaiser Invitational.

Sorvaag, a junior, and Ganje, the team's lone senior, each drew on their experience to turn in solid seasons. Sorvaag led UND at a pair of events and Ganje topped Fighting Sioux golfers at one.

Those five helped UND to a fifth-place finish at the NCC Tournament, and when all was said and done, 11 different student-athletes saw action for the Fighting Sioux in 2003-04.
